**Waste:**

At Camp Viking we actively work on a better environment and hope that you as a guest do too. At our waste stations we sort plastic, cardboard and newspapers (combustible) separately from metal, glass and pant. You will find separate containers for other household waste (sopor). Instructions can be found at the waste station.

**Entrance gate:**

During check-in you get a code the get in and out the campsite with your car. This code is personal and can not be used by others.

**Bus & train connections:**

There is a bus stop at the entrance off the campsite along the E14. Look for more info at [www.ltr.se](http://www.ltr.se). Trainstation is about 2 km. See [www.sj.se](http://www.sj.se) for more info.

**Bicycles/Kickbikes:**

Remember to take it easy and show consideration when cycling in the area.

**Grill:**

Grilling may only take place in grills. Open fire on the ground is not allowed Except for the specially equipped fire pit (see map). Charcoal must be emptied into special containers at the garbage station.

**Pets:**

Pets are welcome. Dogs must be on a leash at all time and may not stay in our common service areas. Resting takes place outside the camping area, do not forget to bring a dog poop bag.

**Check-in:**

Check-in takes place from 9-12 am & 4-9 pm for camping and 3 pm for cottages on the day of arrival. Please contact the reception in advance if you plan to arrive after regular opening hours.

**Latrine & waste water emptying:**

Latrine & waste water emptying is available near the service house.

**Motor traffic**

Be aware at anytime of other guest and animals who live at the campsite. Think of the speedlimit 15 km/h.

**Noise disturbance:**

Consider at all time about other guests. No (loud) noises may be produced between 11 pm and 8 am.

**Parking:**

You can park your car at the campsite next to your stay. Several vehicles must be parked at the parkingplace.

**Service house:**

The service house is for you who lives on our campsite or in a simpler cottage. The service house is open 24 hours a day.

**Cleaning of cottage:**

Cleaning equipment is available in all cottages. You can also buy for final cleaning, contact the reception.

**Security:**

Fire / emergency: save first, alert sos on telephone 112, extinguish the fire. Fire extinguishers are located in several places, see map.

**Check out:**

Check-out takes place no later than 11 am. If you wish to check out before the reception has opened, please contact the reception the day before departure.
